I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- 2. As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets

etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.

- 4. All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
- You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians
 and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other
 course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
- 6. Besides above, it is also pertinent to mention here that, as per section 12.2 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 30th April of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-
 - 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
 - 11.4.2 To reduce the ad'mission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
 - 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
 - 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
 - 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.
- 7. Further, it is also to inform that the DCI has developed an online module to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, the Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 13.10.2018 at New Delhi has decided that the all the requisite information / documents required as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall be uploaded on DCI website and any hard copy of information /documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall not be considered by DCI.
- 8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II as prescribed in DCI Regulations) for the previous academic session 2021-2022 may kindly be uploaded on DCI website by 30.04.2022, positively, as the said information is required to be uploaded as per request of the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not uploaded by 30.04.2022 on DCI website, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.
- This may kindly be treated as 'Most Urgent'.
- The Dental Council of India ensures Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort.

Sir/Madam.

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- 2. As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of regging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of regging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose deretiction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- 3. All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpfine), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.
- 4. All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
- 5. You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti-ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
- 6. Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.1 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Alwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 30th April of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-
 - 11.4.1 To initiale the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
 - 11.4.2 To reduce the ad mission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
 - 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
 - 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
 - 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.







Department of Prosthodontics

Proethodontics is a branch of dentistry which deals with replacement of missing teeth and other supporting structures (tissues) by an artificial substitute (prosthesis) restoring function and appearance (esthetics) of the patient. The various treatment modalities offered include complete denture, removable partial denture. fixed partial dentures implants and maniforacial prostheses.

The department of Prosthodontics offers comprehensive training for undergraduate students from 1st year to internship. During internship, students are encouraged to make self decision in

treating the patient under the supervision of staff which helps in developing the self confidence.

Department of Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry



Maintenance of oral health and hygiene is difficult with children. Dept of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry aims at providing treatment to improve and enhance the oral health statusof children. The various procedures done in this Department are Root Canal Therapy, Pulpotomy, Pulpectomy, Indirect Pulp Capping, Restorations, Extractions, Oral Prophylaxis etc and preventive therapies like topical fluoride application etc.

This department also takes the responsibility of educating and counseling the parents in maintenance of their child's oral health. Behavior Management of children is another important aspect which is being taken care of in this department. Students pursuing dentistry in 3rd and 4th year are given orientation regarding different conditions that affect the dentition of children and their treatment as well.

Department of Oral Pathology & Microbiology

This department helps to provide knowledge regarding diseases of oral and para oral structures. Students gain knowledge of the basic oral structures and diseases affecting them. The department also has a well established histopathology INE laboratory which processes the diseased tissue and makes the confirmatory report of the disease.

Department of Orthodontics

Department of Orthodontics deals with correction of crowding, irregular, protruding teeth and various other developmental deformities of teeth and jaws utilizing orthodontic appliances commonly known as brackets or braces using different treatment approaches—such as removable, fixed and habit breaking appliances. The treatment consists of follow up at different points in time and requires precision, patience and expertise to fetch optimum results. This department teaches Orthodontics at under-graduate level from 3rd year onwards with theory fectures commencing from 4th year. We teach them to master the art of wire bending and molding them in different appliances to treat various (maiformations) dentofacial deformities. We create beautiful smiles which not only make the person esthetically pleasing but also enhances his confidence.

Department of Community Dentistry

This department deals with preventing and controlling dental disease and promoting dental health through organized community efforts, it is concerned with dental health education of the public with applied dental research as well as prevention and control of dental diseases on a community basis through organizing dental camps in nearby regions of institute.



PRINCIPAL COllege

We have more than 250 deptar chains which are stached with all necessary accessories. Our institution provides different traces of edvanced treatment available in the field of deptistry through the following departments to the needy people.

Distartment of Gest Madicine & Desigles

This department deals with examination of oral devity identifying diseases, defects, deformities and dysfunction. Necessary investigations like taking radiographs of teeth and bones are carried out in this department. Thereafter treatment planning is done. Clinical and theoretical knowledge of all diseases affecting oral cavity, manifestation of systemic diseases & diagnostic procedures pertaining to them is taught. Information of imaging modalities, study of radiation and its use in taking radiograph for oral and orofacial diseases is given. This department takes both intraoral and extra oral radiographs using panoramic radiography (OPG) and gives appropriate diagnosis. Panoramic x-ray machine also has the capability of providing variety of skull projections done with cephalometric attachment to machine.

Department of Cral & Maxillofactal Surgery

The surgical treatment in dentistry is performed in the department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery. The minor surgical procedure like extraction of teeth, surgical removal of impacted tooth, surgical removal of small pathologies like cysts & tumors of the oral cavity are done here under local anesthesia. In this specialized field of we also treat deformities in face, thin and drail skeleton musculature. These surgenes are known as orthographic surgeries which are done for correction of maxillary and mandibular discrepancy under general anesthesia. The cause & correction of developmental disturbances like cleft tip & cleft palate are also done in this department. The management of traumatic facial injuries like fracture, mandible, maxilla and associated soft bissue injuries are also done in this department.

Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics

Conservative dentistry is a branch of dentistry which is concerned with the preservation of teeth in mouth. It is broadly categorized as conservative dentistry and endodontics, its chief goal is to conserve and preserve every bit of tooth to natural esthetic and functional form.

The department has a huge phantom head laboratory with simulators and complete assembly for appropriate training concerned with different treatment modalities. The treatment modalities rendered in the department include restorative procedures for carious teeth and other defects of the teeth like fractures, erosion, abrasion etc. Various esthetic treatment options like diastema closures, veneers, tooth whitening etc.







MEASURES FOR CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS -IMPLEMENTATION OF DIRECTIONS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA - information as per section 12.2 of DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009 to be furnished by 30.04.2018 - Regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- It is also to inform you that if an institution fails to curb ragging, the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:
 - 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
 - 11.4.2 To reduce the admission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
 - 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
 - 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
 - 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.
- Besides above, it is also mentioned that, as per section 12.2 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Alwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 30th April of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which action mentioned in Regulation 11.4 would be initiated against defaulting institution.
- 5. All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.

- 7. You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
- 8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II-, already available with your institution) for the <u>previous academic session 2017-2018</u> may kindly be sent to us <u>by 30.04.2018</u>, positively, as the said information is required to be sent to the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not received by <u>30.04.2018</u>, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee.
- This may kindly be treated as 'Most Urgent'.
- The Dental Council of India ensures Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort.

MEASURES FOR CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS -IMPLEMENTATION OF DIRECTIONS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA - Information as per section 12.1 of DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009 to be furnished by 31.10.2017 - Regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- It is also to inform you that if an institution fails to curb ragging, the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:
 - To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act. 1948.
 - 11.4.2 To reduce the admission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
 - 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
 - 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
 - 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.
- Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.1 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 31st October of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which action mentioned in Regulation 11.4 would be initiated against defaulting institution.
- All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.

- You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians
 and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other
 course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.amtiragging.in/www.amanmovement.org.
- 8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II-, already available with your institution) for the <u>previous academic session 2016-2017</u> may kindly be sent to us <u>by 31.10.2017</u>, positively, as the said information is required to be sent to the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not received <u>by 31.10.2017</u>, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.
- This may kindly be treated as 'Most Urgent'.
- The Dental Council of India ensures Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort.
