Health Facilities for Students at Mansarovar Global University

1. On-Campus Health Centre

- The university maintains a Health Centre staffed with a **full-time qualified Medical Officer**, along with nursing and technical support staff.
- It operates 24×7, providing basic medical services and handling emergencies.
- The facility includes a pharmacy / medicine dispensary to supply medicines for students when needed.

2. Emergency & Ambulance Services

- An ambulance service is available on campus for emergencies.
- The health centre is equipped to respond to urgent medical situations (first aid, stabilization) before referring students to specialized hospitals if required.

3. Preventive / Wellness Services

- Regular health checkups, screening programs, and maybe awareness camps (e.g. for common conditions) are part of the health services. (Though explicit details for all programs are not always stated, such offerings are common in similar universities.)
- First-aid kits are placed at strategic locations across campus for minor injuries or emergencies.

4. Tie-ups with Hospital

• For private or specialized care beyond what the health centre provides, the university has an on campus super specialization 650 bedded hospital

5. Health Support in Hostels

- Hostel residents have access to the on-campus health facility. Health / medical support is part of hostel services.
- Monitoring and safety arrangements (e.g. for emergencies within hostel premises) are in place.
