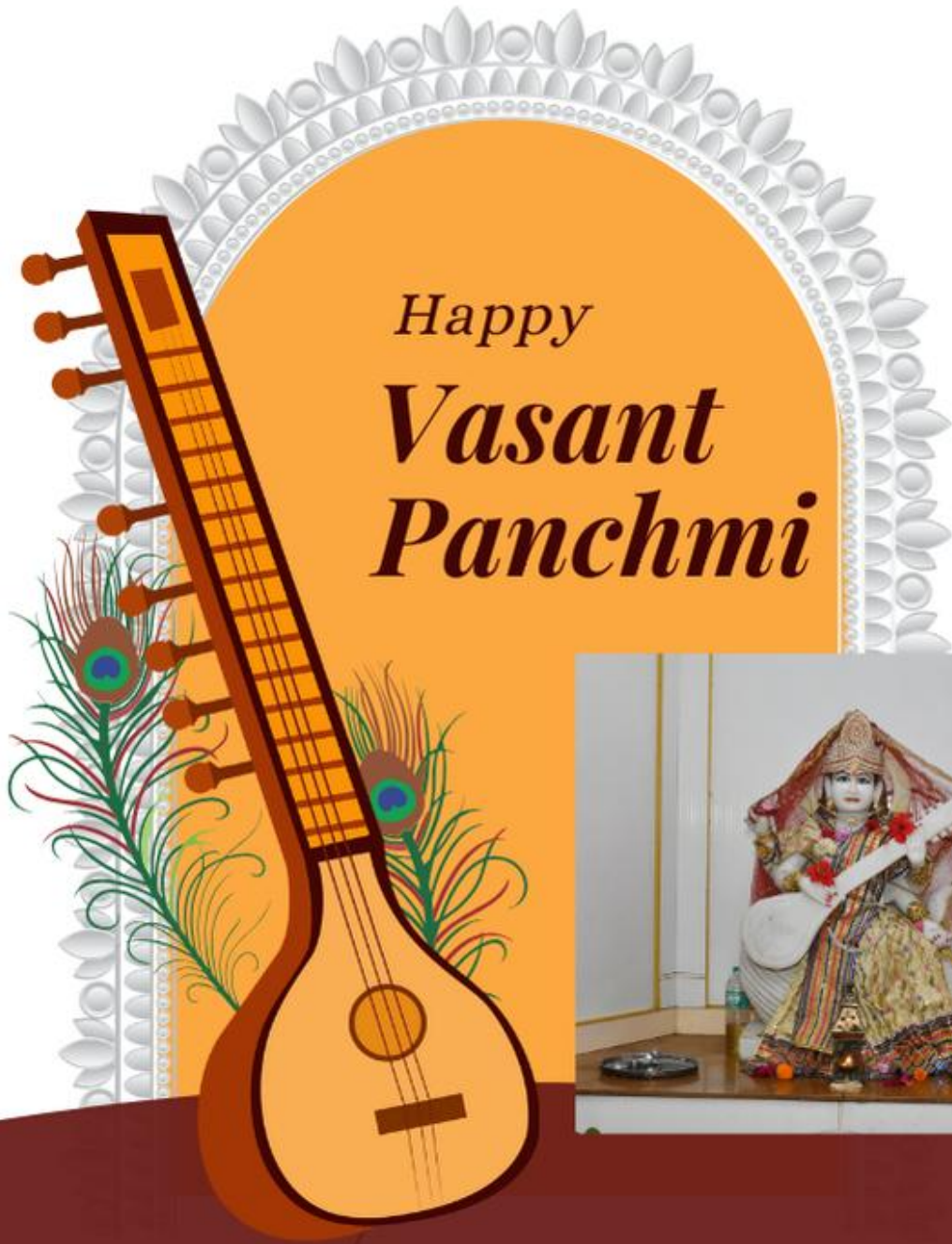
NATIONAL NEWSPAPER DAY

SUCCESSFUL BIRD COUNT PROGRAM AT HATAIKHEDA RESERVOIR



MIE - MIGRATORY BIRD IDENTIFICATION



On 8th February 2025, a Bird Count Program was successfully organized at Hataikheda Reservoir under the joint collaboration of Bhopal Birds , Mittal Institute of Education, Department of Science (Mittal Nature Club) and the General Forest Division, Bhopal. The primary objective of this initiative was to identify and document the local and migratory bird species found in the reservoir.

During the program, a total of 60 bird species were recorded, with active participation from students of Mittal Institute of Education.

CAN HUMANS MIGRATE TO MARS?

Can Humans Migrate to Mars? Mars remains our horizon goal for human exploration because it is one of the only other places we know where life may have existed in the solar system. What we learn about the Red Planet will tell us more about our Earth's past and future, and may help answer whether life exists beyond our human planet.

Like the Moon, Mars is a rich destination for scientific discovery and a driver of technologies that will enable humans to travel and explore far from Earth.

Distance of Mars from Earth is around 33 million to 249 million miles and it is always changing but the population is zero and forecast that it is -284 degrees F to 86 degrees F. A day on Mars (24 hrs, 37 mins) is very close to an Earth day.

Moving to Mars is now easy; it comes with major challenges. Current spacecraft take 6-9 months to reach Mars. A round trip nearly 2 years. Mars is freezing (-60 degrees C on average), with dust storms that last for months. The Martian atmosphere is 95% carbon dioxide—without a spacesuit, you wouldn't last a minute. Mars lacks a magnetic field, meaning humans would be exposed to high levels of cosmic radiation.



To make Mars habitable, scientists and engineers are working on artificial habitats: pressurized, temperature-controlled shelters to live in. Extracting water from Martian ice for drinking and farming. NASA's MOXIE experiment has already produced oxygen from Mars' atmosphere. Scientists are testing how to grow crops using Martian soil.

Engineers and scientists around the country are working to develop the technologies astronauts will use to one day live and work on Mars and safely return home to Earth.
