



Professionalism, vision and wisdom for their overall development, apart from just improving textbook knowledge.



Eligibility Criteria*

(as per Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India & Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of M.P. norms)

UG - BAMS

Senior Secondary School Certificate (10+2) or intermediate with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects or its equivalent **Certificate/ Diploma** with the above subjects recognised by Govt. (Minimum 50% for UR, 45% for SC/ST/OBC)

- NEET qualified
- Age should be 17 to 25 years as on 31st dec of the year of admission.
- If eligible, student will be admitted only through relevant Central/State Govt. counselling.



Duration

- 4.5 years + 1 year of rotatory internship



DEPARTMENTS



Department of Kayachikitsa

(Internal Medicine)

Since ancient times there have been two schools of treatment in Ayurveda; one of surgery and the other that of medicine. With Kaya meaning body and chikitsa meaning treatment, Kayachikitsa is one of the eight branches of Ayurveda that deals with general medicine. The department lays the foundation for students to become a skilled Ayurvedic physician.



Department of Shalya Tantra

(Surgery)

Shalya Tantra is the ancient science of surgery that is best ascribed to when the body is beyond medicinal repair. Management of haemorrhoids and fistula in ano, cuts and wounds, application of leech, medicated thread (ksharasutra) as well as bone setting, all come under the department's purview. The department of Shalya Tantra would provide students with a basic understanding of the principles of modern surgery.



Department of Shalakya Tantra

(ENT, Dentistry, Ophthalmology)

The department of Shalakya Tantra deals with the diseases and disorders affecting the Ear, Nose, Throat, Eye, Dental, Head and Neck. Students will be given specialised training to treat various eye diseases, conditions like sinusitis, migraine etc. for which there is no match other than Ayurveda.



Department of Stri Roga and Prasuti Tantra

(Gynaecology & Obstetrics)

We impart specialised training in Ayurvedic Gynaecology & Obstetrics in the department of Stri Roga and Prasuti Tantra. It also treats diseases of the female genital tract, venereal diseases, menstrual disorders while ensuring healthy baby delivery and conditions related to maternity as well.



Department of Dravyaguna

(Ayurvedic Pharmacology)

Ayurveda has its peculiar way of understanding the pharmacology of natural substances originated from natural sources i.e.vegetative, animal, mineral and marine. It is done through meticulous analysis of taste, potency, bio-transformation and physical-chemical properties of the drug. Students will be educated in natural drug research, identification of rare drugs, adulterants as well as substitutes used in Ayurvedic practice in the department of Dravyaguna.

DEPARTMENTS

Kaumarabhritya

(Paediatrics)

Kaumarabhritya concerns with the new-born care, taking care of diseases affecting children as well as specialised rituals and treatments for postnatal care of mothers. Students will be imparted training on the same lines.



Department of Swasthavritta

(Social and Preventive Medicine)

Ayurveda believes in the following a disciplined routine and adopting a healthy lifestyle to maintain good health. Swasthavritta defers to those ideas with the help of Naturopathy and Yoga. Students will be taught about its principles and practice at both an individual and communal level.



Department of Maulika Siddhanta

(Basic Principles of Ayurveda)

The department of Maulika Siddhanta concerns the foundational wisdom of Ayurveda. It would help you understand classical Ayurvedic texts, basic principles and history of Ayurveda, and Sanskrit language, the medium of these classical texts. The essence of Ayurveda is taught in this department.



Department of Rasyashastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana

(Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacy)

The department of Rasyashastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana is concerned with the selection of genuine raw drugs, their collection, processing of poisonous herbs, manufacture of herbal, herbal-mineral, herb-metallic formulations and their therapeutic indications, dose, vehicle and diet. Students will learn to formulate these medicines from minerals and metals and understand their medicinal chemistry.



Department of Rachna Sharir

(Anatomy)

The surgical school of Ayurveda helped practitioners understand the minute structure that makes up the human body. It pioneered the technique of treating bodies in flowing water and exposing the underlying structures by scraping the skin. Students will be able to critically understand modern and ancient views on human anatomy while also getting taught about dissecting cadavers.



DEPARTMENTS



Department of Roga Nidan and Vikriti Vigyaan

(Pathology)

The philosophy of Ayurveda dictates that a disease be treated as soon as it has developed. Early detection of disease, identification of imbalances that may have contributed in the development of disease with the help of Ayurvedic diagnostic techniques (also taking into account modern methods of investigation) all come under the department of Roga Nidan and Vikriti Vigyaan. Students will be taught in all these ancient Ayurvedic techniques as well as in relevant modern investigations.



Department of Agada Tantra and Vyavharayurveda

(Toxicology, Jurisprudence and Forensic Medicine)

Where Agada Tantra is concerned with the study of toxicology and different sorts of toxins and poisons along with their antidotes, Vyavharayurveda concerns medical jurisprudence and forensic medicine (post-mortem and autopsy findings as well). Students will be trained in deciphering toxins and delivering their antidotes, medical jurisprudence as well as conducting and formulating forensic reports.



Department of Kriya Sharir

(Physiology)

At the heart of Ayurveda is its Dosha Dhatu Mala philosophy. Dosha refers to an imbalance of quintessential elements that make up a human being, Dhatu means tissues which support the body and Mala means waste meant to be expelled out of the body. Students are encouraged to learn about human physiology and how the Dosha Dhatu Mala philosophy could help in creating a healthy internal flora, maintaining the delicate internal balance and expulsion of waste and toxins.



Department of Panchakarma

Panchakarma etymologically translates into 'five therapies' with Pancha meaning 'five' and karma meaning 'therapies'. It is an Ayurvedic therapy that clears out toxins from the body accumulated through disease, poor nutrition and unhealthy environment. It includes Vamana, Virechana, Nasya, Basti Karma & Rakta Mokshan. Students will be equipped with an understanding of Shodhana (includes Panchakarma purification therapy) methods at this department.

Panchakarma Therapy

Many chronic diseases can be treated through Panchakarma as it helps the body heal itself by promoting cell regeneration and eliminating toxins. Almost all Panchakarma procedures are conducted in our hospital on the OP & IP basis.


